Many people from different communities have been blessed in their lives by their participation in our Adult Education program, CHE Trainings and community development work in four different communities.
- For the leaders of Jhurjhure church in Chitwan who have experienced many blessings. Many new believers traveling long distances have been added to their church after the CHE volunteers have visited homes and provided friendly advice and training regarding health, and education in this last year.
- For Jamuna in Salyan as she helped to complete Adult Education training in seven churches in the last eight months with the help of seven trained NFE teachers from the local communities. Now there are many other churches asking us to help in this great need in their communities.

Please Pray...

- All our CHE Trainers as they plan their activities for the new Nepali year (2076) in a staff retreat and led by God's word from Joshua 1-6. All of them have been blessed in the last year with good success in their communities and two of them have planned to explore new communities where there are no churches or house fellowships.
- For victims of the tornado that suddenly hit a few villages of Bara and Parsa Districts in the terai. Many have been rendered homeless as most roofs and mud buildings got blown away and about 29 lives were lost (mostly women and children) and almost 300 people injured. There was also loss of many heads of cattle (cows, buffaloes, goats and chickens). Our CHE Trainers Suleman and Arun, with the help of some locals, provided relief in one badly affected community (Bharbaliya' village of Pheta Rural Municipality) with food, water, and also medicine and temporary sheds and tents to keep them safe from the very unusual weather we are experiencing in Nepal these days.
- For our son, Prateek, as he finishes high school here in Nepal and explores the possibilities of college admission outside Nepal. He has performed well academically but he will require a fair bit of financial support to get admitted in college of his choice.

- Because of some changes, we are debating how to continue the ministry in Russia. Pray that God will keep that door open and provide the resources in people and finances to continue the training there (which has been handled by a Ukrainian national, Roman).
- Pray for Ukraine. They elected a new president who has no political experience and is a comedian and TV star. Someone explained it as people electing a "dream" president—the guy who can do it all—lower taxes and raise benefits, stop the war with Russia and be friends with Russia at the same time moving into the European Union and stopping corruption. He won 73% of the vote with basically no political platform. It makes the country very vulnerable. But a big issue for us is that under the incumbent president there was great religious freedom. All of that could change quickly and dramatically. Pray that God's Kingdom would continue to go forward in this land with such great potential.
