Our two younger sons began college on August 4th at one of the best colleges in Bhutan, Royal Thimphu College (www.rtc.bt). We are praying for safety and healing for all and for the current pandemic situation which has taken place globally.





MISSION AND CHURCH ACTIVITIES

We have done several programs, which includes the appointing of leaders and elders (about 96 all over Bhutan), six wedding ceremonies, and completing the 16th batch of Bhutan Friends Bible School. Students were taught about the Old Testament, the New Testament, and the facts and history of the four gospel books of Jesus and their authors. The students were also taken on a field trip. The new training center is in the heart of Thimphu city. We have added ten new members to our church, and they all took a public display of baptism.

Praise God...

- For giving all of us good health in spite of the crises created by the COVID-19 virus in Nepal. All our CHE trainers, leaders and committees have reported that they are now actively conducting CHE training again, and many are taking the help of on-line facilities in continuing with the CHE Trainings.
- We have been blessed with a good monsoon season so far for our farming communities in the terrain and also some in the hills. Landslides have happened as is usual at this time of the year, but people are now able to take care of themselves in a much better way by the preparedness lessons being taught in our training sessions.
- For success in the Bardia Hand Washing Station business which helped us reach communities far off, and our promise of good after sales service helping in giving us a good opportunity to evangelize among the non-believers directly into their offices and homes.

Please Pray...

- Our communities in Province 2 (Rautahat, Janakpur, Mahottari) and Bardia Districts being very badly affected by the Coronavirus due to migrant laborers crossing over from India by foot. Many did not understand the importance of being quarantined and were let loose in their own families and communities unaware of by the government. Since there are no jobs in these areas there is lot of hunger and crime in these communities.
- Our efforts to teach people of the communities to make hand sanitizers and face masks for personal use and also for other people in their churches so that all can be safe. Many nonbelievers came forward to be helped by these trainings and we could share with them the love of Christ.
- For the Children of Aurahi village who are being helped in learning about Christ and witnessing to their family members.
 As every year, Arun is busy during this monsoon season treating snake bites and fevers and has to attend calls at even nighttime and whenever called.
- Dr. John Khadka is asking for prayers for him as he completes one year after graduation from medical school and where he has worked in Chaurjhari mission hospital which has inspired him tremendously enough to motivate him to serve on a long time basis in future in other similar and very needy remote rural communities to serve Jesus. He is now seeking to work under some more senior doctors which necessarily means moving from his present job to another bigger hospital also in rural Nepal. He is also considering appearing for his postgraduate entrance exam this year.

Please pray for the logistics to be worked out. Please pray for God to show up in a big way when my application lands on an immigration officer's desk. Pray for favor and provision.
- Gateway Friends wants to ensure that we do not end up having two congregations, one that comes in person and one that watches from home. We are working to integrate our congregation and remain connected while being mindful of the different levels of comfort each church member has with meeting in person. Please pray as we launch programs and work to be intentional about connection and fellowship, which looks very different in these COVID times.
- I'm moving into my final year of graduate studies at Barclay College online. Please pray for time management, listening ears, perceptive eyes and open heart to what God has to teach me in each of my classes.

Pray especially for displaced people whose villages have been burned by the Gumino forces. Many have fled to the Moyen (Middle) Plateau where Friends have 72 families (577 displaced people) among thousands.

- For Scott and Andrea Sward and Elise Paty living in Stueng Treng. Praise God for their partnership with a YWAM team focused on the Kavet people group.
