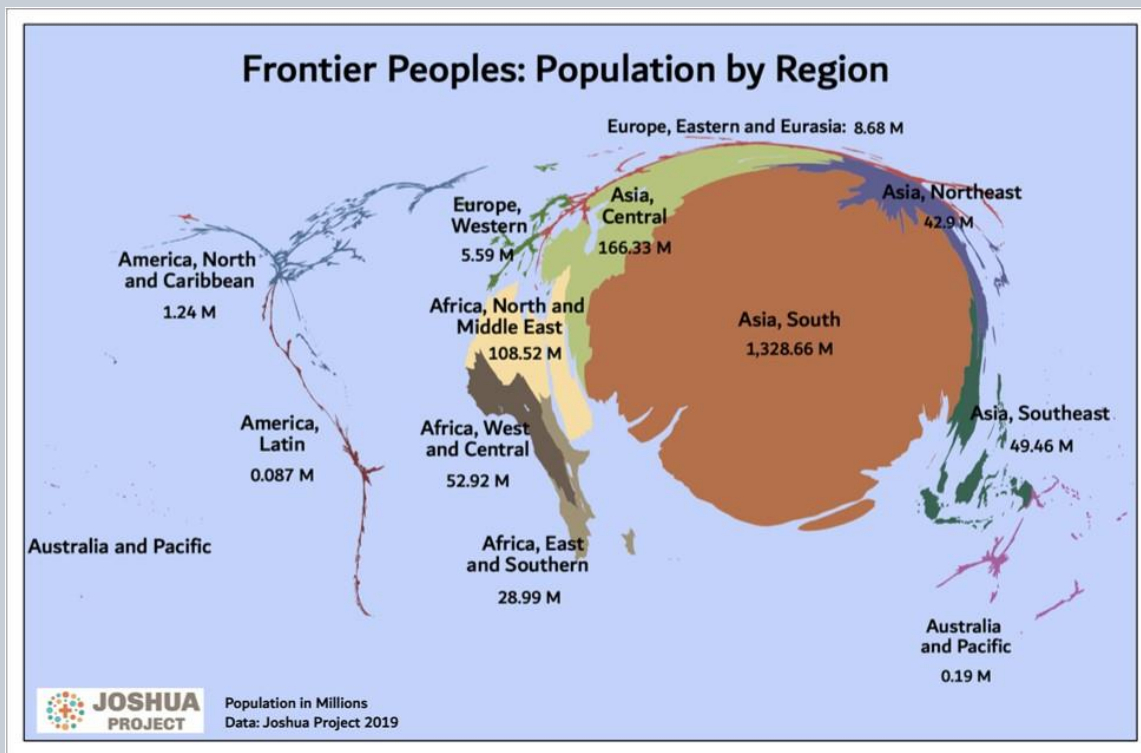
November 2020 Prayer Letter

In Matthew 9:37-38, Jesus said to his disciples, *“The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”*

When Jesus said, *“the harvest is plentiful,”* he wasn’t kidding! David Thomas found the infographic below that gives us one way of seeing how huge the harvest is today. It also shows us where most of the people groups who have not heard the Gospel are located. Please take a moment to ponder what this infographic tells you.



Frontier People Groups (FPGs) are Unreached People Groups with 0.1% or fewer Christians of any kind, and no evidence of a self-sustaining gospel movement. According to the Joshua Project there are currently about [5,047 Frontier People Groups](#) with a total population of 1,941,674,000. **One fourth of the world lives in FPGs and these people have almost no chance of hearing about Jesus unless workers come from the outside to share the Gospel with them.**

Jesus continues to say, *“Ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest.”* EFM believes that he wants Evangelical Friends of North America to send out **at least ten new missionary households to launch at least five new fields over the next five years**. Will you pray with us that that will come to pass? If so, please send us a message at this [link](#) to let us know you are praying about this specific need. - Keeping us safe and sound during these difficult days brought on by the COVID-19 virus. We have trained to help and encourage many people living around us and working with us, and this helped us to remain calm and occupied while the Lord did his work.
- The churches in Mahottari among the Dalits (Musahars & Dom community) which are growing after miraculous healing experienced by 2 persons recently. One of them was very sick with Pericardial effusion with tamponade caused by Tuberculosis. Whole families are coming forward and asking for prayer and joining us in our village fellowship and Kiran conducted some classes on the importance of and demonstrated the use of a contactless Hand washing machine.

- Dan Bahadur and his family in Bajhang, and his 16 year old overweight daughter (Pratigya) who has Cerebral Palsy. It has been very difficult for the family to manage her as she is becoming unmanageable at home and hinders their normal activities. He has five other children, all younger, and as winter sets in soon in the Far West Nepal, this family will need all your prayers and support to keep them warm and going.
