
In all these, we give God the praises and glory for his faithfulness to his people. We continue to lift our church family to the Lord for his protection, continued favor and provision in 2022!

- We could go everywhere we needed before and after Christmas. We were abroad (Croatia and Serbia), in Ozora, in Pécs, in Budapest, and we could celebrate together. We celebrated in Tolna too (on the 26th of December). Everywhere, we could hand out Christmas packages for children and a new Christian calendar for several families. We could also tell the story of Jesus' birth. In Serbia, Croatia, Kölked, and Ozora, we gave donations for the poor families, and they were so thankful for it. We had a really blessed time everywhere.
- Some people from our church (for example my younger daughter, Betti and her family, my nephew, Daniel and his family) suffered from COVID-19. But glory to our God, everyone was healed and they are fine now.
