EFM 2026 Special Projects List

Updated March 2026

EFM: Future Mission Retreats and Trips, \$7,000 (average \$350 per scholarship)

EFM is investing in annual future missionary retreats where mentors and future missionaries connect for training and coaching. EFM is also providing future missionary trips for field experience and training. The relationships established in these experiences are a gamechanger for EFM's future. EFM: Missionary Stateside Vehicle Replacement, \$15,000

EFM plans to replace one or two of the vehicles which we maintain in the U.S. for missionaries on deputation. We will sell our oldest cars and purchase newer, good used cars to give our missionaries the most trouble-free vehicles possible as they travel with their families in the U.S. \$15,000 is an estimate on an amount needed.

EFM: Missionary Care Fund, \$5,000

This is a special fund started in 2022, inspired by NWYM Friends Women, that is set up and reserved for missionary care. This could include counseling, sabbaticals, or medical care. When funds are used for these special missionary care needs, EFM will be happy to communicate to the donors of these funds as to how they are being used as a blessing to these missionaries!

EFM Asia

- **Replace Missionary Vehicle on Field (\$12,000)**

This growing family needs to replace their existing car with something bigger! They will sell the car they currently drive and are estimating \$12,000 to purchase and equip an Indian made vehicle replacement that will better suit the family's needs.

EFM Bangladesh

- **T-shirts for Youth Conferences (\$900, \$3/shirt)**

EFC-Bangladesh has been holding growing regional youth seminars called “RockTeens” in which they celebrate their faith in Jesus (mostly first-generation Christians) and focus on equipping and sending into the harvest of Bangladeshi unreached peoples. It was requested that we send a small love gift of t-shirt for each participant as an encouragement and reminder of their experience.

- **EFC Training Center Furnishings (\$1,490)**

In order for EFC-Bangladesh to be registered with the government, they are required to provide long-term tangible services to the community which the government considers a felt-need. From the beginning, they have had a training center storefront in Khulna where they have provided computer training and English training, as well as other classes and services. They have used the Jesus Film and gospel message in every way possible to teach English and teach typing, etc. The office and classrooms are needing some updated furnishing!

EFM Cambodia

- **Maternity Waiting Home, \$5,000**

The mission would like to build a Maternity Waiting Home beneath a Health Center serving one of the most remote and least developed communes in the province. This Maternity Waiting Home will provide a comfortable space where expectant mothers from hard to reach places can spend the final weeks of their pregnancy.

EFM India

- **Rickshaw Project, \$1800 (\$900 each for two rickshaws)**

Many churches and pastors in India face persecution for sharing their faith. Two of our pastors would benefit from having a rickshaw to have a legitimate business while still being able to evangelize in sensitive areas. Rickshaws are small, 3-wheeled vehicles that serve as taxis in India.

- **Women Skill Development, \$1,000 (100/woman)**

The mission provides tailoring training for women that helps grow their income and opens the door to share the gospel.

EFM Mexico

- **Third Future Missionary Retreat – Latin America, \$3000 (\$100 scholarships for 30 participants)**

This project provides scholarships for young people and adults exploring a call to missions. Participants attend an intentional retreat where experienced missionaries teach, mentor, and share real-life insights. Through training, community, and guided reflection, they gain a clearer understanding of missionary life and are challenged to take next steps in obedience. Scholarships cover lodging, meals, and partial travel support from their home city to the retreat location. Interest in missionary service is rapidly growing across Mexico and Latin America. Recent retreats have seen strong participation, and momentum continues to build following the first regional Missions Sending Learning Conference in Guatemala, creating new opportunities to mobilize future missionaries.

- **Prayer and Discernment Trips, \$3500 (\$700 scholarship for up to 5 people)**

These trips support the Friends' Vision Mexico 2032 (VM32) church planting project in Mexico. These scholarships would make it possible for a team of five people, including leaders and future church planters, to visit places where Evangelical Friends are not yet present to collaborate with the expansion of the Gospel and seek God's direction to know where to start a new church. This scholarship includes travel expenses, lodging, and meals for a seven day trip.

EFM Nepal

- **Two CHE Trainer Motorcycles, (\$4,000, \$2,000/Motorcycle)**

Two of the CHE Trainers (Community Health Evangelism) working with communities in holistic discipleship in Nepal have motorcycles nearing 10 years old. They plan to sell these and purchase new ones. They continue to expand to new communities in need of Jesus through CHE.

- **Community Center Project, \$2500 (\$1200 each for two Centers)**

This project will provide equipment and furnishings for two Community Learning Centers (CLCs) now registered with the Nepal government and serve as meeting and training centers for the men, women, youth, and children in the Rautahat and Chitwan communities.

- **Jesus Film Project, \$3500**

This project would purchase projector equipment to help CHE Trainers and CHE volunteers in their outreach work. The cost to "The Jesus Film Project" is \$3500 for each set. There have been growing results from some of the faithful evangelists who serve within EFC-Nepal and CHE.

- **Leadership Training and Encouragement Trips \$8,000 (4,000/trip)**

After more than 30 years pioneering ministry in Nepal, this team has transitioned out of full-time field leadership. What remains is a strong, self-sustaining, disciple-making, church-planting movement. In this season of transition, ongoing visits each year will continue to encourage and support local leaders.

EFM Philippines (Independent EFC Churches With No EFM-Paid Workers)

- **Worship Training Camp, \$3,000**

This training will bring together the music teams from various EFC churches (PEFIM) in the Philippines (Pasig, San Mateo, Samar, Palawan) to equip them in skills of worship leading, instrumentation, and team unity.

EFM Rwanda

- **Whole-Life Discipleship \$2,500 (\$35/day/young leader)**

The Lord has brought much transformation into the lives of many people who have been discipled in D for D. At this time, there are some key young church leaders who we have the opportunity to mentor and help prepare them for various roles God might give them in the EFC-Rwanda and beyond.

- **GLLT (Great Lakes Leadership Training), \$8,000**

These programs are invaluable to the leadership and ministry development of countless pastors, leaders, and future leaders, both men and women, in the Great Lakes region of Central Africa. The GLLT budget is underfunded without extra project donations each year and any donations are appreciated.
